Dear Residents,

Disruption to your satellite TV connection from Mon 14 September

During the project to remove and replace the render system on Morrison Court, we also need to access the roof of the building. While doing preparation work, we saw there were several satellite dishes on the roof.

We've looked into this and can see that only two of these are currently in use. Many of the old satellite dishes have cables which are hanging down over the side of the building.

To safely and effectively carry out our building safety work on your building, we need to remove the **dishes and these cables**. We will begin the work on **Monday 14 September**.

This is to ensure that nothing can compromise the new wall system we are installing. Leaving the dishes and cables could mean water can seep into the façade or cables could be removed later which may damage the wall system, and will also make the job much more difficult for our contractors.

As we believe only two dishes are being used, this shouldn't affect everyone in the block – if you get your TV through a virgin box or similar, it is unlikely you will be affected.
