### Design team visit on Wednesday 6 October

The design team will be visiting Grand Union Heights on **Wednesday 6 October** to take some samples of the external wall system. They'll be using a temporary scaffold tower to get the samples, which we anticipate will be around the garage.

The samples are needed for us to test the system we hope to use on the building to ensure we are using the correct materials. Some of the materials are no longer on the market so we need to be able to test them for a good substitute into the new system.

### Why is it taking a while to decide on a design?

Grand Union Heights has a complex external wall system – we think it is unique in London. Because of the makeup of the external wall, we need to ensure that the new design works structurally and gives all the necessary fire protection.

We've had several options on the table and these samples and the test we'll be doing, will help us to reach the best design going forward. We'll be writing to you again soon to give you more information about the testing and the contractor for the project.

We work on a three-month update basis, so you can expect to hear from us every three months or sooner if we have something confirmed which we need to tell you.
