New bin store arrangements

As you are aware, cladding remediation work has started at Rainbow House. So far, we have completed the ground works, erected a scaffold to Section C and installed a hoist.

You may have noticed that Mullaley has erected a gantry – due to limited space on-site, this is sited above the resident's bin store area. After communications with our structural engineer, we must install propping to the bin store area to support the weight generated from above. This is a necessity to ensure the structure of the building is not compromised. This means the bins are inaccessible in this bin store. We have decided to house all the bins in the leaseholder bin store for the remainder of the project.

Therefore, from **Friday 26 November** until the conclusion of the remediation works, that bin store will be locked and out of use for residents. Your fobs will no longer give you access; instead, **please dispose of waste in the leaseholder bin store.**

All the bins that were in the resident bin store will be moved to the leasehold bin store ahead of time. We will re-programme all fobs to give access to the leasehold bin store.
