### **Project webinar with contractor on Tuesday 14 June at 6pm, work to start Monday 20 June**

I'm glad to let you know that we have agreed with the original developer Kier that remediation work will begin on **Monday 20 June**. As such, we will be holding a webinar on **Tuesday 14 June at 6pm** to go over the specifics of the remediation project and you will be able to ask us any questions related to the proposed Kier work.

We had a webinar in April which mainly discussed the insurance situation with the balconies at Cipher Court, although there was some other useful information for residents of Cabinet Court and Code Court too. #### **What will we cover at this webinar?**

We will provide an update on the Cipher Court balconies, however as we explained in April, this does not form part of the cavity barrier work being done by Kier. We'll go over all the ins and outs of the project specifics, including:

- Remediation work required, plus site plan and layout
- Programme timeline and EWS1 form
- Introduction to Kier.
