Main consultant appointed and site visit undertaken

We have appointed Calford Seaden as our main consultant on this project and they will covering several crucial roles within the design team and going forward; project manager, contractor administrator, cost control, CDM principal designer (CDM is the Construction – Design and Management Regulations), clerk of work. We'll continue to work towards appointing the remainder of the design team which will include the architect, who will act as the lead designer. We'll also appoint other team members such as a façade engineer and a fire engineer.

Last week we carried out a site inspection with Calford Seaden to familiarise them with the site. Due to the building's location, there are additional challenges when carrying out this project, given the proximity of the health centre, the railway line and other buildings.

Alongside Calford Seaden, we also need to take into account the commercial units underneath the buildings while the project is being remediated on-site.
