### **Update on webinar**

We wrote to the other blocks in Matthews Close earlier this week as we will be carrying out some fire door surveys in their blocks over the coming weeks. We will write to you before we start surveys in your blocks.

In the letter, we also included a small update about the date for a resident webinar and so have included that below.

#### Webinar date

We've not yet confirmed a date for the webinar to explain the external wall project, but as we said in our last update, we'll let you know once we've got a date confirmed.

## Why aren't we doing these surveys yet in Moss House?

We will carry out these surveys on Moss House, but we are currently focussing on our buildings over 18 metres. The other three blocks at Matthews Close are above this measurement, while Moss House is below. We will write to you when we have a date confirmed for your building's fire door inspections.

We work on a three-month update basis, so you can expect to hear from us every three months or sooner if we have something confirmed which we need to tell you.
