Dear residents,

Fire tests in December/January, plus consultation on play area and landscaping

We let you know in our last update that the original contractor wanted to carry out a fire test on the proposed solution to remediate issues within the external wall system. There will be two fire tests, one before Christmas and one in January. Once we've heard from them about how the tests have proceeded, we will let you know.

Consultation on landscaping and play area

You'll know that the play area on the lower rooftops of Peppermint Heights have not been able to be used for safety reasons. As part of the project to remediate the issues within the external wall system, we also want to remove the unused play area and provide some play equipment which can be used and enjoyed.

We are proposing to have a new play area on the ground floor, close to the current sport area. We want to consult with you on what you want and how you would like the area to be used. This project would also involve new landscaping on the ground floor outdoor area. We will be holding a webinar next year to go

over the potential ideas for the space. We will also be sending out a survey to gather your views so we can include some of them in the final design of the space. We'll write to you again nearer the time with joining instructions and when we have a date confirmed.

Your building's fire strategy is simultaneous evacuation, which means you must evacuate if you hear the fire alarm, even if you think it is a false alarm.
