

Trainee Steel Fixer

Job Description:

As a Trainee you will work under the supervision of a Steel Fixer and will aid in the construction of concrete frames, working outside.

Person Specification:

You should:

- Have numeracy skills, manual dexterity, and the ability to use tools.
- Have good practical and problem-solving skills
- Have a second language such a Romanian, Albanian or Russian Preferable
- Have an awareness of safety issues and regulations
- Must be able to take and follow precise orders from supervisors and colleagues. This
 requires the ability to listen very carefully and communicate effectively.
- Be physically fit and able to work at height
- Be able to work as part of a team
- Be 18+ years old
- Demonstrate a sound work ethic
- Deal with the public in a positive, courteous, and respectful manner
