Remediation work finished, scaffold removed, EWS1 form to follow

I'm pleased to say that the remediation of the external wall system at Hindon Court has been completed ahead of schedule. This was a relatively short programme, but I'd like to thank you for your cooperation and understanding while we have completed this work. The scaffolding has also now been removed.

EWS1 form

An EWS1 form rates the fire risk at a building and can be a requirement to sell, remortgage or staircase your property. We expect to receive the EWS1 form from our fire engineer within 6-8 weeks. We'll send it to you as soon as we have received it and carried out our due diligence.
