Dear residents,

External wall investigations - progress on low priority investigations.

We have used the government's prioritisation tool to guide us on the prioritisation of inspections on external walls on buildings between 11 and 18m. As a result, we now expect if an investigation of your building is required, it will begin after April 2025.

We will write to you again before any investigation starts on your building and we will let you know the outcome of the inspections as soon as we know the position.

If you wish to move home whilst the inspections are underway, we have relaxed the rules for our shared owners allowing them to let their property. If this is something you wish to do, please contact us on customerservice@networkhomes.org.uk.

At this point we are not able to confirm who will pay if any remedial works are required. Much will depend on what we discover in the inspections, the responsibility of the contractor and warranty provider and the availability of government funding.

We'll write to you again before the inspections start or in September 2023.
