Removal of scaffolding in courtyard elevations from Tuesday 30 May

The scaffold will begin to be removed on the courtyard elevations at Avery Court from **Tuesday 30 May**.

Safety during the scaffold removal

While the scaffold is being removed, the contractor will have a small "set down" area fenced off on the grassed podium level where scaffold poles will be stored for a short period before they are taken away. This will be fenced off and there will be marshals sited during working hours to stop scaffolders while residents are passing. This set down area will only be while the scaffold is being struck and this should take 3-4 weeks to complete.

All staircases will remain open, however when exiting the building, please use lifts and staircases that go to street level.
