Minor works today and EWS1 form due in February

Following the completion of the remediation of the external wall system at Matthews Close, we wrote to you to say the contractor needing to carry out some minor works. This took place today, to repair the panels and brickwork that were damaged during the works. The final scaffolding will now be removed.

EWS1 now due in February

We wrote to you in December stating our fire engineer was drafting the EWS1 form. We hoped it would be ready for January 2024, but due to demands on the fire engineer, the form is still being prepared. We expect to receive the form by the end of February.
