Cleaning

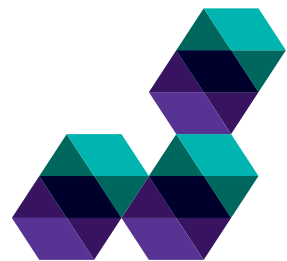
Internal communal areas are cleaned Monday to Friday between 8.00am and 4.00pm. Individual blocks will be cleaned within this period.

All bins (recycling, general, and food waste) are collected and emptied every week on a Thursday.

Removing bulk items

Fire safety

Please make sure you dispose of cigarettes safely and make sure all corridors and communal areas are kept free of items. Any items left in the communal areas will be removed without notice.

Fire strategy

The fire strategy at Vantage Point is a **stay put** policy. This means unless you're directly affected by a fire or told by the emergency services or a Network Homes staff member to evacuate, you should stay in your home.

Building safety drop in session

Following the residents meeting on 9 January, a drop-in session has been arranged for residents to meet with the Fire Safety Team on Friday 7 February between 8.00am and 1.00pm at Archer Tower.

Sprinkler system and fire alarms within flats

Our contractors are very close to completing the works required to fit the sprinkler system and fire alarms in all flats within Archer Tower.

Waking Watch at Archer Tower

We're still operating a security waking watch at Archer Tower on a 24 hour, seven days a week basis until we've completed all relevant works to the flats. Please note fire wardens are authorised to check people's identities to maintain security at the site.

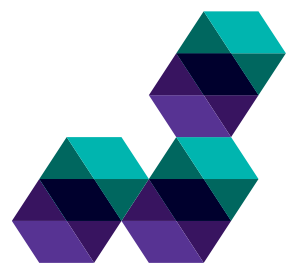
